Long answer questions.

Q1.- What first aid would you provide in following cases? A) sprain b) severe burn

Ans.- First aid is provided as follows:

Sprains: Ice packs can be used to reduce swelling. Some pain relieving ointment can also be used to get relief from pain. An elastic bandage can be wrapped around the joint which gives support to the joint and prevents movement.

Severe burns: Blisters should not be pricked otherwise, it can get infected. If blisters do break wash them with antiseptic liquid and cover with a clean piece of cloth to protect from germs and also from dust and insects.

Q2.- What is a splint? How and why should it be used?

Ans.- Something like a magazine, piece of cardboard or wood or a pillow that is tied around the fractured bone to give support and prevent movement of the broken bone is called a splint. It gives support to the fractured bone. When the leg is fractured, splint is tied around it and it does not allow the patient to move his or her leg at all.
