

**Rules for Changing Singular Nouns to Plural Nouns**

**Singular nouns:** name one person, place, or thing.

**Plural nouns:** name MORE than one person place or thing.

 <p><b>s</b></p> <p>For most words add "s".</p> <p>boy → boys</p> <p>clock → clocks</p> <p>teacher → teachers</p> <p>dog → dogs</p>	 <p><b>es</b></p> <p>For words ending with <b>ch, s, sh, or x</b> add <b>es</b>.</p> <p>church → churches</p> <p>dress → dresses</p> <p>wish → wishes</p> <p>box → boxes</p>
