Q 1. How many selection tools are present in MS Paint? Name them.

Ans. There are two selection tools present in MS Paint. These are – Free-form selection tool and Rectangular selection tool.

Q 2. What do you mean by zooming an image?

Ans. Zoom means to increase or decrease the view size of an object on the screen in any ratio.

Q 3. How can you skew an image in Paint?

Ans. Skew means to turn the picture sideways at an angle. To skew an image in Paint:


- i) Select the drawing tool by using the Select tool.
- ii) Select the Resize option in the Image group on Home tab.
- iii) Specify the value of the Skew option in degrees for both horizontal and vertical, in the respective boxes. Click on ok.

Q 4. How can you enter text in MS Paint?

Ans. To add text in MS Paint:

- i) Select any shape from the Shapes group on Home tab. For example, Cloud call out shape and draw it on the drawing area.
- ii) Now, select the Text tool and then select any color.
- iii) Click inside the shape. A dotted rectangle appears with cursor inside it. Now, type the text as desired.
