
The letters in red above are called vowels. All the other letters are called consonants.


The words given above are naming words. We use a or an when we talk about one naming word.

We use an before a naming word that is one and begins with a vowel sound.




When to use 'a'

We use a before a naming word that is one and begins with a consonant sound. **Examples:**

a house a car a dog a book a toy a cake a school a man


