



Is, Am, Are, Has, Have

Let's Begin

Work in pairs. Read aloud the following conversation.

I **am** Ankit.
He **is** Amit.
She **is** Reena.
They **are** my friends.

I **am** Rohan.
She **is** Meera.
We **are** in the same class.

Note, how **is**, **am** and **are** have been used above.

We use **am** with the pronoun **I**.

We use **is** with **ONE**—singular noun or pronouns like **he**, **she**, **it**, **this** and **that**.

We use **are** with **MANY**—plural nouns or pronouns like **you**, **we**, **they**, **these** and **those**.

Examples:

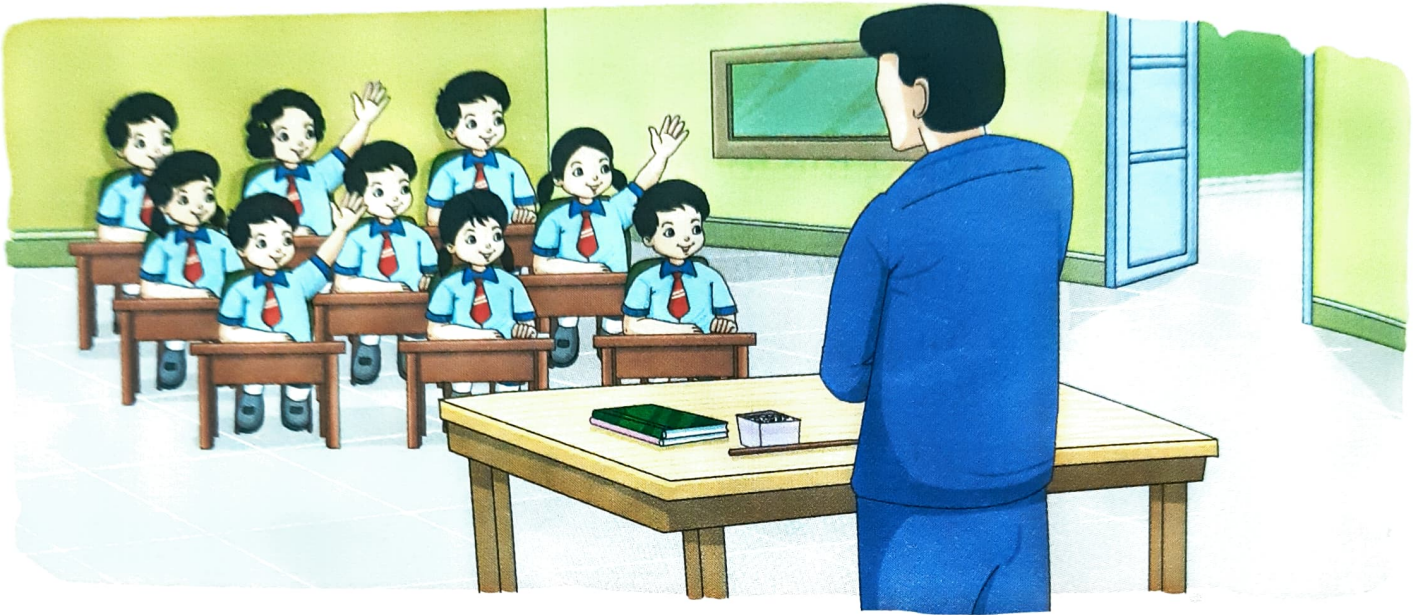
I am a good girl. I **am** in Class I.

He is a smart boy. He **is** my brother.

They **are** my friends. They **are** in my class.

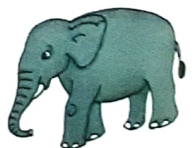

Remember

We use **has** and **have** to say that something belongs to someone.

Has is used when there is **one** person, place, animal or thing.

Has is used with **he, she** and **it**.



Have is used when there is **more than one** person, place, animal or thing.

Have is used with **I, we, you** and **they**.

Examples of **Has**

Tanisha **has** long hair.

He **has** a blue pen.

She **has** a pretty doll.

It **has** a long trunk.

The lion **has** a beautiful mane.

Examples of **Have**

Riya and Roma **have** short hair.

I **have** a red bicycle.

We **have** a big house.

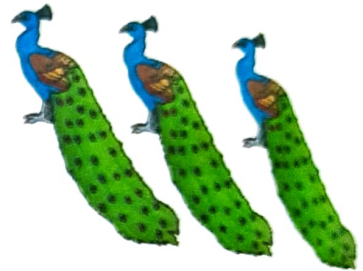
You **have** beautiful eyes.

Zebras **have** black and white stripes.
