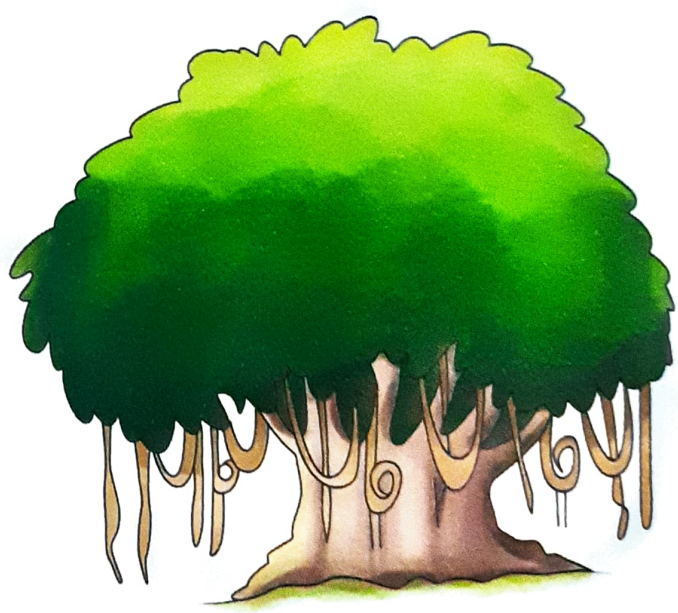

I think I'd fall down

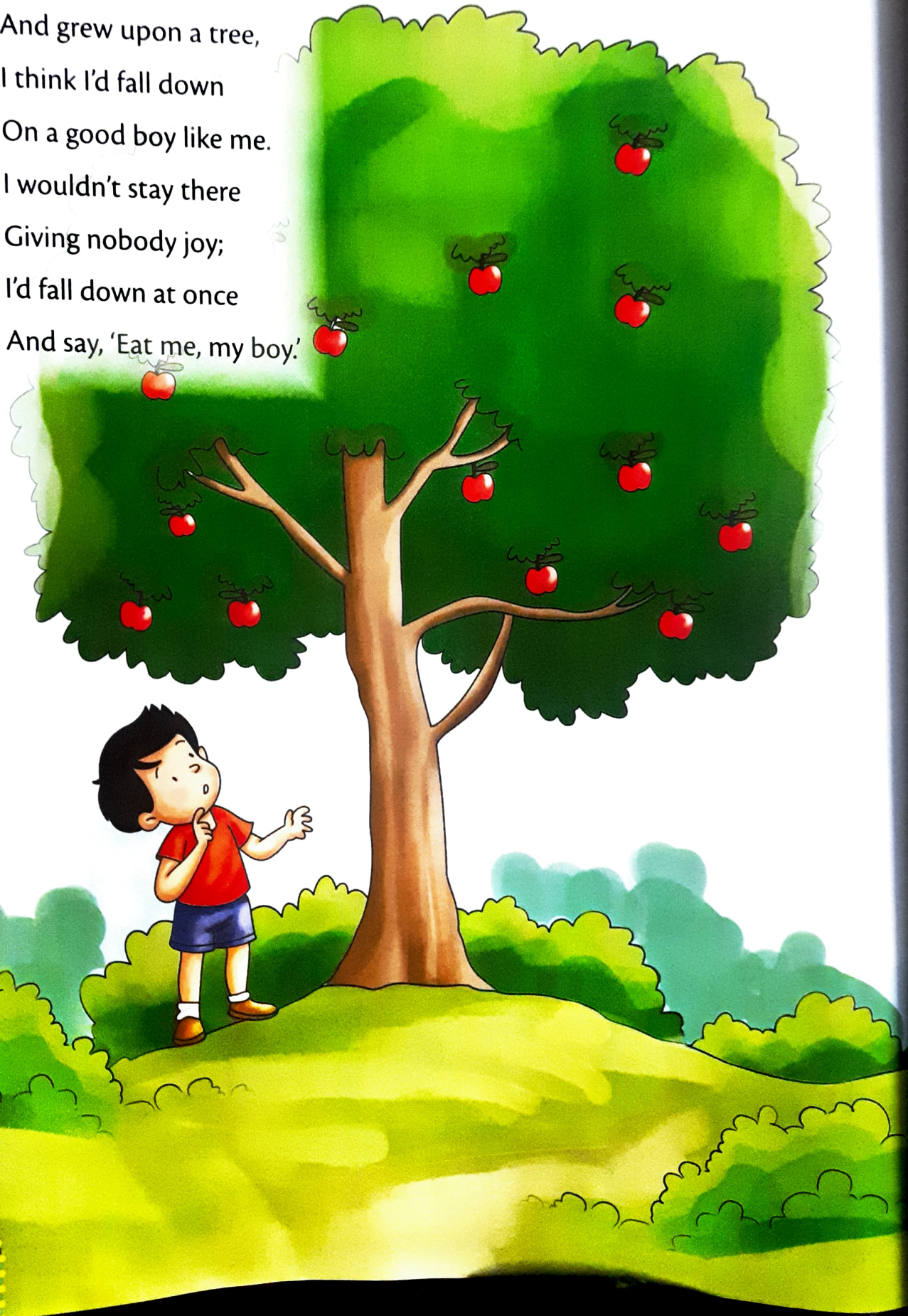
On a good boy like me.
